## **L** DRUGS SAFETY

- Codeine use in certain children after tonsillectomy and/or adenoidectomy may lead to rare, but life-threatening adverse events or death
- Selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors. Use during pregnancy and potential risk of persistent pulmonary hypertension of the newborn (in USA) and cases of bleeding (in New Zealand)
- Proton pump inhibitors. Reports of acute renal reactions, primarily interstitial nephritis
- Benzyl alcohol-containing parenteral products: risk of gasping syndrome
