DRUGS SAFETY

- ACE inhibitors, angiotensin AT-II 1 receptor blockers and pregnancy: fetal renal impairment.don't expose fetuses.
- NSAIDs: acute kidney injury, in children also. Special caution is needed in children at risk of dehydration.
- SSRI antidepressants: brain haemorrhagea 1.5-fold increase in the risk
- Metoclopramide: restricted indications, dose and duration of use
- Drug-induced optic neuropathies in brief
