4 DRUGS SAFETY

- PIOGLITAZONE-CONTAINING MEDICINES Risk of bladder cancer
- DIRECT-ACTIND ANTIVIRALS FOR HEPATITIS C TREATMENT Potential risk of hepatitis B virus reactivation Interaction with vitamin K antagonists and changes in INR
- ORAL ISOTRETINOIN Potential risk of impotence (erectile dysfunction)
- CODEINE AND TRAMADOL
 Restriction of use in children and advice against use in breastfeeding women
- FACTOR VIII MEDICINES No clear evidence to suggest a difference in inhibitor development between plasma-derived and recombinant products
- INTRAVENOUS N-ACETYLCYSTEINE FOR PARACETAMOL OVERDOSE Reminder of authorized dose regimen; possible need for continued treatment with N-acetylcysteine
- AMIODARONE (INTRAVENOUS) Risk of adverse effects of the heart in newborns
- OPIOIDS AND BENZODIAZEPINES COMBINED USE INCREASES RISK OF OVERDOSE
- FUROSEMIDE Risk of dermatitis lichenoid
